The Code of Conduct presents a vision of excellence in seaplane aviation within its seven sections: (1) General Responsibilities of Seaplane Aviators; (2) Care of Passengers and People near the Seaplane; (3) Training and Proficiency; (4) Security; (5) Environmental Issues; (6) Use of Technology; and (7) Advancement and Promotion of Seaplane Aviation. The Code of Conduct is a “living document,” periodically updated to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment.
